
Norton Village Hall Old Tewkesbury Road, Norton, GL2 9LJ

from the south turn left for Wainlode Hill & Bishop's Norton hall is on the left immediately after the school


from the north bear right for Bishop's Norton & Wainlode Hill hall is on the right immediately before the school just before rejoining the A38



- 3. All cups and trophies remain the property of the Branch and must be returned upon request.
- 4. All classification and judging will be based on the **11th** edition of the BCSS Handbook of Shows.
- 5. The judges may, at their discretion, withhold any award where they consider the standard of entries to be too low.
- 6. Objections must be stated to the Show Secretary by 2:30pm on the day of the show.
- 7. All entries must be staged between 9:00am and 10:30am on the day of the show and must remain until the close of the show.
- 8. The Society and the show organisers accept no responsibility for exhibits and personal property whatsoever, but all reasonable care will be taken.
- 9. The word 'succulent' when used in this schedule refers to any succulent plant other than a cactus.
- 10. A novice is a member who has not gained a first prize in any BCSS open show.
- 11. A junior is a member under 18 years of age.
- 12. Entry forms should reach the Show Secretary by the date shown thereon.
- 13. Entrance to the show constitutes acceptance of these rules.
